Pisanki is the traditional Eastern European custom of decorating Easter eggs. Pisanki is derived from the Polish verb “pisac” which means “to write.” Decorations are created by drawing on the eggshell with molten wax and then immersing it in dye. Visit us to decorate your own egg. Registration for St. Clair Shores residents begins February 25. This class is for ages 7 to adult; if you are signing up your child, please also reserve a spot for yourself as seating is limited.
