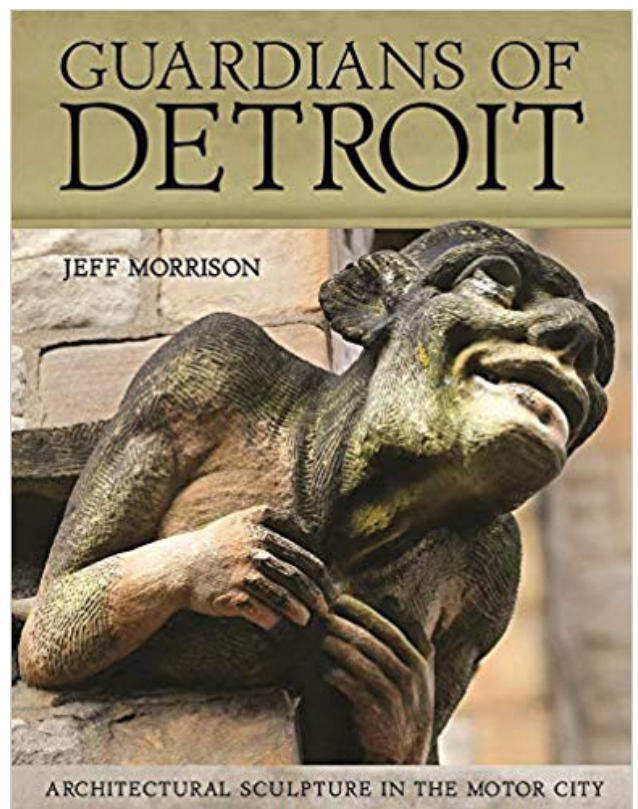


Guardians of Detroit

Local author Jeff Morrison will present a selection of stories and photographs from his new book *Guardians of Detroit*. This volume is the first-of-its-kind project to explore, document, and explain the singular collection of architectural sculpture, including gargoyles, grotesques and other features on Detroit's buildings.

Using a 600mm lens and 23-megapixel camera, Morrison brings sculptural building details barely visible to the naked eye down from the heights, making them available for up-close appreciation. He will share the stories of the buildings and the artists, artisans, and architects who created them. Everyone is welcome to this free event!
