

# *Pysanki Easter Egg Decorating*

Pysanki egg decorating is an Eastertime tradition in Eastern Europe. Pysanky comes from words meaning “to write” or “to inscribe” because the designs are created on eggs using a stylus that etches decorations into the beeswax covered egg.

Registration is required and begins March 15 at the Library; \$20 per person. Seating is very limited. The class will include an egg to decorate, instructions and use of decorating supplies.
